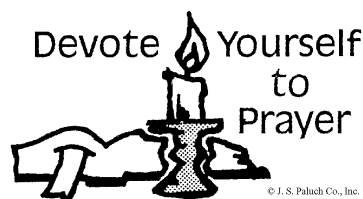

13. In what ways does Apostolic Tradition occur?
